



Code of Conduct for Children (General Members – not racers or high performance)

As a member of Oval Ski Club I agree to abide by the Children's Code of Conduct.

- I will arrive promptly for snowsports activities and allow enough time to be ready to start at the agreed time
- I will dress appropriately for the activity and weather conditions including long trousers, long sleeves, gloves and helmet where appropriate (when racing poles are in use).
- I will show respect and courtesy to instructors and officials at all times and understand participation in snowsports is only possible due to the time volunteers give freely to help myself and other children
- I will try my best and listen to instructors and officials at all times
- I will show respect and courtesy to other snowsports participants at all times
- I will abide by the club rules
- I will not be involved in any bullying or practices that can be deemed as bullying
- I will not use the internet, phone or other electronic device to make derogatory remarks about other people involved in snowsports, or clubs, or anything related to snowsports that could bring the sport into disrepute
- Report any concerns I have to my instructor, Club Welfare Officer or parents/carers
- I will demonstrate sporting behaviour in all my activities and promote good sportsmanship, being modest in victory and gracious in defeat
- I understand that if I do not abide by the Club rules I may be subject to disciplinary action
