We're delighted to announce that the Club Holiday is back for 2024! After a successful holiday in 2019 we are returning to the Hotel Aiguille Rouge in Les Arcs 2000.

LES ARCS

Les Arcs is made up of six separate villages, with Arc 2000 being the highest village at an altitude of over 2,100m. Traffic free, this modern purpose built resort is a little soulless, however offers all the practicality that a resort built with the sole purpose of accommodating the modern winter sports enthusiast should provide. A short gondola connects 2000 to its very pretty close neighbour, Arc 1950. This gondola is around 200m from our hotel entrance.



At the southern end of the area is Peisey-Vallandry, where an impressive double decker cable car links the neighbouring area of La Plagne, to create the massive Paradiski Area.

Après-ski and other activities available include paragliding, Nordic skiing, snowshoe walking, dog sledding, ice climbing, walking routes, horse drawn sleighs, cinema, bars and restaurants.

THE PARADISKI SKI AREA

Les Arcs offers long descents, steep stuff and plenty to keep intermediates happy, plus woods to head to in a storm. For those who really like to travel on their skis or board, the link to La Plagne takes the area to the 3 Valleys league.

The link between Les Arcs and La Plagne is served by the amazing Vanoise Express, an engineering masterpiece, a double decker cable car straddling a mile deep valley making the link quick and efficient.

The carefully considered lift system is the areas biggest boast offering 137 lifts, servicing 425km of pistes. The chairlifts are noted for their speed and comfort.

For beginners Les Arcs has plenty of nursery slopes and several excellent ski schools. Intermediates are in paradise with endless wide, confidence-inspiring blues and reds. For experts there is the challenging descent from the Aiguille Rouge to Villaroger in the form of a 7km black run which descends over 2,000m. Snowboarders are spoilt for choice with terrain parks and plenty of off-piste.

With the highest skiing at 3,250m, the Paradiski area is known for its late season snow records; with conditions on the upper slopes remaining good for the whole day.





ACCOMMODATION

The hotel is a proven winner following the 2019 club holiday. Part of the Belambra group, it is superbly located at the bottom of the Aiguille Rouge, as well as being right on the slopes with a central location in Arc 2000. It offers a full range of activities along with a good standard of accommodation. There is a choice of room types, some of which fit a third bed suitable for a child, and include some inter-connecting twin rooms.

Skiing is available to and from the door, whilst the ski school meeting point is only a four minute walk away.

The hotel offers excellent facilities including a bar and lounge with a south facing sun deck and a panoramic restaurant overlooking the piste. WiFi is available at an extra charge. The hotel runs a kids' club for 3-10 year olds, a variety of board games are also available, together with table football and a pool

table (at an extra charge). The 218 rooms are served by three lifts.

An excellent hot and cold buffet breakfast caters for all tastes, whilst the evening buffet provides a selection of dishes that change every night. Free, unlimited wine accompanies the evening meals.



FLIGHTS AND OTHER INFORMATION

The outbound flight is Jet2 scheduled for 09:30 from Manchester to Chambéry (two hours). The transfer time to the resort is just over two hours. The return flight will get back to Manchester shortly after 14:30. Other regional flights are available on request.

The holiday is booked direct with Inghams Ski, an ATOL bonded company. Further details can be viewed on the operator's website [here](#).
