La plagne

La Plagne is home to one of the Alps' most impressive and varied ski areas, with numerous villages to ski to and explore, all of which have their own unique character.

The Club will be staying in Plagne Centre, the focal point of the resort. It is the most vibrant of the villages, offering the largest range of shops, restaurants and bars.



At the western end of the ski area is the impressive double decker cable car linking the neighbouring area of Les Arcs, to create the massive Paradiski Area.

Après ski and other activities available includes Paragliding, Nordic skiing, snowshoe walks, dog sledding, ice climbing, walking routes, horse drawn sleighs, cinema, bars and restaurants.

The Paradiski Ski Area

La Plagne offers long descents, plenty of steep stuff and plenty to keep intermediates happy, plus woods to head to in a storm. For those who really like to travel on their skis/ board, the link to Les Arcs puts the area in the 3 Valleys league.

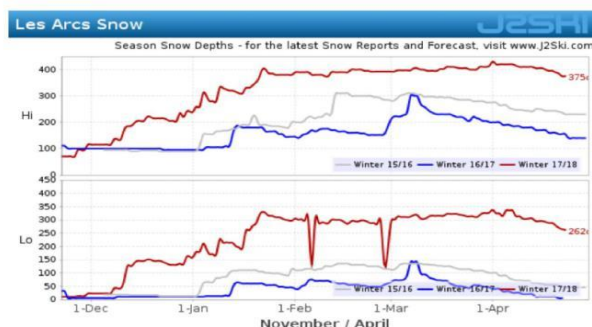


The link between Les Arcs and La Plagne is served by the amazing 'Vanoise Express', an engineering masterpiece, a double decker cable car straddling a mile deep valley making the link quick and efficient.

The carefully considered lift system is the areas biggest boast offering 137 lifts, servicing 425km of pistes. The chairlifts especially noted for their speed & comfort.

For beginners La Plagne boasts plenty of nursery slopes and several excellent ski schools. Intermediates are in paradise with endless wide, confidence-inspiring blues and reds. For experts there is the challenging descent from the Aiguille Rouge to Villaroger in the form of a 7km black run which descends over 2000m. Snowboarders are spoilt for choice with terrain parks and plenty of off-piste.

With the highest skiing at 3250m, the Paradiski area is known for its late season snow records; with conditions on the upper slopes remaining good for the whole day.



Accommodation

Hotel Le Terra Nova is highly rated by many reviewers, and described by our own Stu Haselgrove as his "go to hotel when staying in the La Plagne area". Part of the Belambra group, this 3 star accommodation is superbly located in the village of Plagne

Centre. As well as being right on the slopes it has a great central location being extremely well connected to access the areas lifts and pistes. It offers a full range of activities along with a good standard of accommodation. There is a choice of room types, from a limited number of single rooms (at a supplement), to twins, triple and quad rooms.



Skiing is available to and from the door, whilst the ski school meeting point is only a short walk away.

The hotel offers some excellent facilities including a cosy bar and lounge, and a panoramic restaurant overlooking the piste. Free WIFI. A sauna is available to sooth tired limbs, together with table football & pool tables (at extra charge). With live music most evenings. The 119 rooms are served by lifts.

An excellent hot and cold buffet breakfast caters for all tastes; whilst the evening buffet provides selection of dishes that change every night. Free, unlimited wine accompanies



Flight & Other Information

The outbound flight is a TUI charter flight from Manchester to Chambéry (2 hr flight). The transfer time to the resort is just over 2.5 hours. The return flight will get back to Manchester in the early evening. Other regional flights are available on request.
